## Sharps Island Lighthouse Timeline (The leaning light of the Chesapeake Bay)

1838	First lighthouse, a wooden tower, built on the island (900 acres).
1848	Lighthouse moved inland due to erosion (now – 450 acres).
1855	Lighthouse refitted with 5 <sup>th</sup> order Fresnel lens.
1865/66	Second light, a screwpile, built on shoal.
1881	Screwpile destroyed by ice. Structure w/ keepers aboard carried away by ice floes.
1882	Present caisson, 54 feet tall constructed. 4 <sup>th</sup> order lens lit on February, 1882.
1890s	Resort hotel built on eroding island.
1900	Island shrinks to 94 acres.
1940s	Island completely disappears
1976/77	Lighthouse tilted by impact of heavy, moving ice. Lens removed and replaced by 250mm plastic lens. Deterioration of tower continues.
